



90-Day Inspection Checklist & Instructions

What is the 90-Day Inspection and who can do it?

Outdoorsy requires a technical inspection every 90 days of any vehicle listed on Outdoorsy. This requirement is a condition of insurance coverage and helps ensure that listed vehicles meet our certification standards. We reserve the right to request proof of inspection, including copies of service records, photos, invoices, etc, to determine vehicle certification and insurance coverage eligibility. Per our Terms and Conditions, a claim or dispute may be denied if there are missing or insufficient maintenance records.

Who can do a 90-Day Inspection?

Using the checklist 90-Day Inspection Checklist as a guide, Owners can hire a professional to inspect their vehicle or complete the inspection themselves. If the inspection is done by a professional, ensure that the Professional Inspector Contact section is completed for verification purposes. If you inspect your own vehicle using this checklist, please thoroughly document the condition of each inspection point using photos, videos, invoices, etc. You may be asked to provide unaltered photos or videos and dated receipts, service records, or inspection reports.

How do I use this checklist?

This checklist is intended as a guide and is not sufficient proof of an inspection on its own. You should save all records related to the maintenance of your vehicle such as tire service or replacement, oil changes, repairs, tune-ups, etc. If you are doing your own inspection it is crucial that you document the condition of each inspection point and save it in your records. In addition to records from professional services, you can take photos and videos of the inspection points as you go through the checklist. We have provided a “Documented?” checkbox to help you keep track of your documentation progress as you go through the checklist. We reserve the right to request inspection documentation at any time.

Checklist Key Terms:

- **CHECKED AND ACCEPTABLE** - inspection point is in good condition and road-ready
- **MAY NEED FUTURE ATTENTION** - inspection point is functional but may need repair or replacement in the near future
 - Example: tires are nearing unacceptable tread or are over 5 years old, awning fabric is beginning to fray at the edges which could lead to a tear, etc.
- **NEEDS SERVICE** - inspection point needs repair, replacement or service
 - Once you finish the service and bring the item to good condition, document the repaired item and save with your maintenance records
- **N/A** - inspection points that do not exist on your vehicle/trailer or are not used during rentals
 - Do **not** use the “N/A” box for any inspection points that are in use while your vehicle is rented

3. Document the condition of each inspection point using photos, video, service records, invoices, or receipts. You may be asked to send documentation of your inspection so keep it readily available in case of a claim or dispute.
4. Use the “DOCUMENTED?” checkboxes on the right to track your documentation progress as you go through the checklist.
